Uniform Policy

Daarul Uloom Islamic School believes that a mandatory school uniform policy will provide a more secure school environment, promote an atmosphere for greater discipline, enhance solidarity, and increase learning opportunities for students by removing many of the distractions and connotations associated with various types of clothing.

DU students are required to wear uniforms to class. Students shall be expected to maintain a neat, clean, and well-groomed appearance at school. The first responsibility for maintaining proper standards belongs to the student and parents, or guardian. Parents are responsible for ensuring that their children wear the designated school uniform clothing as outlined below.

Uniform for Boys

PreK1 & PreK2: The uniform policy is optional for these grades. Students are required to wear non-marking soled shoes at all times.

Shirts (KG-8th): Students are required to wear long or short-sleeved light blue polo shirt.

Sweaters/Turtle Necks (KG-8th): Navy blue sweaters may be worn. They should be free of logos, stripes, emblems and other decorations. Students are permitted to wear navy blue turtleneck shirts. *Sweat shirts with hoods are strictly prohibited.*

Undershirts (KG-8th): Students may only wear a solid white long or short sleeved T-shirt under the dress shirt. Colored shirts and logos are not permitted underneath uniform shirts.

Pants (KG-8th): Solid navy blue pants for KG – 8th grade.

Shoes (All grade levels): Solid white or black sneakers without logos should be worn at all times.

Uniform for Girls

PreK1 & PreK2: This uniform policy is optional for these grades. Students are required to wear non-marking soled shoes at all times.

Shirts (KG-5th): Students are required to wear long or short sleeve light blue polo shirts. Shirts must be free of logos, stripes, emblems, and other decorations.

Shirts (6th-8th): Students are required to wear only long sleeve light blue polo shirts. Shirts must be free of logos, stripes, emblems, and other decorations.

Sweaters/Turtle Necks (KG-8th): Navy blue sweaters with may be worn. They should be free of logos, stripes, emblems and other decorations. Students are permitted to wear navy blue turtleneck shirts. *Sweat shirts with hoods are strictly prohibited.*

Jumpers and Pants (KG-8th): Solid navy blue jumpers must be worn with solid navy blue pants. Abayas are optional for all girls. Abayas must be plain black with no decorations.

Hijab (7th & 8th): The scarf is optional for girls 5th grade and below. **Scarves must be worn during salat for 2nd grade and up.** 7th & 8th grade students must wear a one or two-piece fitted solid white hijab. **Shoes: (All grade levels) Solid** white or black sneakers without logos should be worn at all times.

Accessories: Hats are not to be worn in the building. Girls may wear stud earrings only. Make-up of any kind is strictly prohibited.

Violations

The administration will determine if the uniform policy has been violated. Any prohibited items of clothing will be taken by school officials and returned to the parent or guardian only. On special school days, the principal may not require students to wear the uniform. During these times, students must wear attire that is in accordance with school policy and the Islamic dress code.

Consequences for violations

- **First Offense:** Student will receive a pink slip regarding the dress code violation for the parent to sign and return to the office.
- **Second Offense:** Contact parents or guardian and allow them the opportunity to bring the missing item(s) to school, or allow them to take the child home to dress in the proper uniform.
- **Third Offense:** Contact parents or guardian and allow them the opportunity to bring the missing item(s) to school, or allow them to take the child home to dress in the proper uniform. Student will lose recess.
- **Fourth Offense:** Contact parents or guardian to pick up the student for the remainder of the day.
